After making its official debut at the SEMA show just months ago, the Vortech Superchargers team have helped bring the Tjin Edition of the 2011 Ford Mustang GT back into the limelight for a primo photoshoot. This uniquely styled 2011 Mustang GT, is tweaked out by Neill Tjin—it's sure to make you take a second peek. To top it all off, the Mustang also features a nitrous system as well as [Magnaflow](#) exhaust.

While he doesn’t like to make a big deal about his birthday, Carroll’s earned our loyalty over the years. He deserves all the attention.”

Baer Brakes will sponsor the new Baer Brakes Speed Shop Challenge. Beginning at 1 p.m., drivers will charge as fast as they can for 1,000 ft. and then go as deep as possible into a 20 foot by 40 foot box.
